

CHARTERS TOWERS COMBINED AGENTS PRIME AND STORE SALE MARKET REPORT Wednesday – 13th March 2024

Charters Towers Combined Agents yarded a total of 2,051 cattle, consisting of 661 prime cattle & 1,390 store cattle. The Prime cattle consisted of 193 Bullocks, 123 Heifers, 270 Cows and 75 Bulls. The Store section consisted of 656 Steers, 135 Mickeys, 510 Heifers and 89x89 Cows & Calves.

Cattle comprised of some small lines of well finished Ox and Cows; however, the overall condition and quality of the yarding was mixed. The yarding was drawn from Cloncurry, Georgetown, Julia Creek, Hughenden, Pentland, Ingham, Ravenswood, Mingela as well as local and coastal areas.

Prime Quotes:

Bullocks were quoted 20¢ easier, Heifers were 30¢ easier, Cows were 15¢ easier, and Bulls were 10¢ easier on last Sale's rates.

- Best Priced trade Heifers were presented on a/c Braceborough Pastoral, "Braceborough", Charters Towers that sold for 230¢/kg and weighed 480kg to return \$1,104 per head.
 - The top pen of Cows were sold by Fernlea Farming, Brandon for 218¢/kg, weighing 576kg to return \$1,257 per head.
- Bulls sold on a/c BW & MI Landsberg, "Homeview" Charters Towers topped at 300¢/kg and weighed 520kg, to return \$1,560 per head.
